- For younger children the Aerobie Dogobie (yellow or blue) is an excellent choice – £7.95 online, just **£7.50**.
- Also available are Aerobie Sprint Ring (yellow, blue or red) - £10.95 online, **£10.50** and Aerobie Pro Ring (red or yellow) - £12.95 online, **£12.50**.
- And for Junior Ultimate Frisbee the 145g Discraft J-Star (white or orange) - £10.95 online, **£10.50**.

All classes will be taking part in Frisbee sessions.
