GNOME ALONE

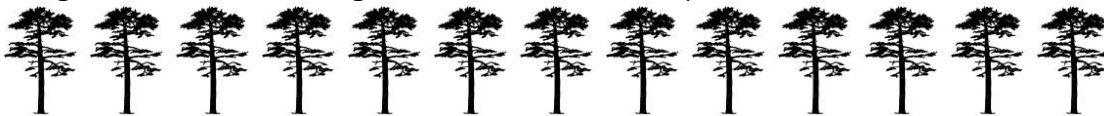
