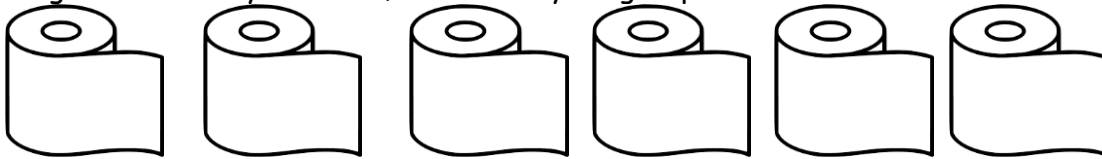
COOK BOOK
