- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and Sports Leaders
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake; mistakes are part of learning

If we believe this code of conduct not to have been adhered to at any of the competitions, we will speak to the Head Teacher of the Primary School concerned. Repeated issues may result in spectators being banned from future competitions.
