

## In the event of Covid Symptoms

What to do if.....	Action needed	Return to school when...
....My child has coronavirus symptoms (temperature, loss of normal taste or smell, constant cough)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Do not come to school</b></li> <li>● Contact school daily</li> <li>● Self isolate</li> <li>● Get a test</li> <li>● <b>Inform school of test result</b></li> </ul>	... the test comes back negative and no longer have symptoms similar to coronavirus they can stop self isolating Or 10 days whichever is first.
...My child tests positive for Coronavirus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Do not come to school</b></li> <li>● Contact school daily</li> <li>● Self isolate for at least 10 days from the onset of their symptoms</li> <li>● <b>Inform school of test result</b></li> </ul>	After 10 days even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell as these symptoms can last weeks after the virus has gone.
...Someone in my household has Coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Do not come to school</b></li> <li>● Contact school daily</li> <li>● Self isolate</li> <li>● Household member to get a test</li> <li>● <b>Inform school of test result</b></li> </ul>	If the household member tests negative, then children can return to school, otherwise it is 14 days.
....Someone in my household tests positive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Do not come to school</b></li> <li>● Contact school daily</li> <li>● Self isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	.... The child has completed 14 days self isolation
NHS 'Track and Trace' have identified my child as close contact of somebody with confirmed coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Do not come to school</b></li> <li>● Contact school daily</li> <li>● Self isolate for 14 days</li> </ul>	The child has completed 14 days self isolation
... a child/staff member in my child's bubble is sent home with suspected coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All children and staff in the bubble will remain in school until Health Protection England advise school</li> </ul>	.. advice will be given from Health Protection England.
